

 - a. For people who needs VISA, you book your flight after it's issued.
- 5. [Suggested date for applying Tourist VISA] by8 May or ASAP
- 6. **[Pre-Departure briefing]** 26 May
- 7. [Program] 2 June to 15 June
 - a. Congratulations! You are on your journey to explore the business landscape in Japan!

ADVICE REGARDING VISA APPLICATIONS



VISA Application Process

If you are a Hong Kong SAR, Malaysia or Indonesia Passport holder, **VISA** is waived under a certain condition.

If you are students who holds either a PR China, Vietnam or other countries passport, you may need to apply for Short-Term Stay VISA

It usually takes up to 15-28 days to be issued, so please proceed by 8 May or ASAP
